- produce a financial return for inventors, departments and the University




# It is the objective of Cambridge Enterprise to:

#### Ways of working with industry

Knowledge transfer may be achieved through various models; practice is often a combination of:

- Open Science open source, research usually published; unrestricted
- Research Office

 Collaborative Research – IP rights owned by University, sponsor has some rights

- Research Office
- Interactions with companies and impact building
- KTFs
- Consultancy IP rights usually owned by the client
- Licensing IP rights owned by University but transferred to third party for commercialisation
- Venture Creation facilitating companies to take innovations forward, including funding them; IP rights transferred to the spin-out

- CE Consultancy team
- CE Tech Transfer team
- CE Seed Funds team
